Question of the Week
March 3, 2024



All catechesis flows from the liturgy nothing is as important as what happens at the Sunday Mass. Question of the Week:

Adults: What in the first reading touched you? What line or word in this reading caught your ear?

Reading 1: Ex 20:1-17

Reading 2: 1 Cor 1:22-25

Gospel: Jn 2:13-25
